

Bristol Bus Information

In late August, the Bristol Board of Education releases a morning bus schedule for Bristol residents for the upcoming school year. As a cost-saving measure, high school students from the same neighborhood will be bused together.

- St. Paul students living in the Bristol Central High School district will be transported to or walk to Bristol Central to pick up a transfer bus to St. Paul. The transfer bus will be situated in the back of the school by the cafeteria. Walkers must be ready to board the transfer buses no later than 7:15 a.m.
- St. Paul students living in the Bristol Eastern High School district will be transported to or walk to Bristol Eastern to pick up a transfer bus to St. Paul. The transfer bus will be situated near the front entrance. Walkers must be ready to board the transfer buses no later than 7:15 a.m.
- Even if they don't use the bus in the morning, students will need to know their morning route number and bus stop so they can tell the driver in the afternoon.
- There will be two buses in the afternoon, one for the Central district and one for the Eastern district. Students will be transported back to their morning stop. Walkers will be transported back to the high school where they boarded the transfer bus. There is no transfer bus in the afternoon, and only St. Paul students will be riding.
- On Wednesday afternoons there will be only one bus for all Bristol students from St. Paul. On Wednesday afternoons, one week the students from the Central district will get home first, and the next week the students from the Eastern district will get home first. In other words, on alternating Wednesdays students will have either the usual ride to the location of their morning stop or may be on the bus until after 3:00 p.m.
