St. Mary Scholarship

Guidelines and Criteria for 2024-2025 Awards

The Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools announces the availability of St. Mary Scholarships for academic year 2024-2025 to Archdiocese of Hartford Catholic High School and Elementary School Students.

- 1. The number of awards and value of each to be determined by the FACS Distribution Committee from all qualified applications received by the due date.
- 2. The student's family **must be parishioners in good standing at the Annunciation Parish (St. Mary Church or Holy Spirit Church in Newington)**. Verification of membership at Annunciation Parish will be confirmed prior to award of scholarship.
- 3. Student must have financial need and academic promise.
- 4. Interested candidates/families of **students currently attending St. Paul Catholic High School** should complete the scholarship application and forward it with all supporting documentation to the Finance Office by **March 4, 2024**. The President will complete the Principal Statement and sign the application, certifying its completeness before forwarding it to FACS.
- 5. Interested candidates/families of incoming freshman applicants should have the student's 8th grade Principal complete the Principal Certification section and attest the application is complete before forwarding the completed application and supporting documentation to the high school by March 4, 2024, the due date established by the high school who will submit the application to FACS.

6. A copy of the student's most recent report card must be included with the application.

7. Completed application forms with all supporting materials are to be forwarded by the school to the Foundation of the Advancement of Catholic Schools office. Supporting materials required to accompany the scholarship application are spelled out on the application form. FACS will not accept applications that are incomplete, have missing supporting documentation and/or are submitted after the due date.
