### David T. Chase Scholarship

#### 2026-2027 Award Guidelines and Criteria

The Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools (FACS) announces the availability of new David T. Chase Scholarships for the 2026-2027 academic year.

1. The Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools will award three (3) **renewable** scholarships in the amount of \$1,250 each from the David T. Chase Scholarship Fund to **a student entering or attending** East Catholic High School **OR** Northwest Catholic High School **OR** St. Paul Catholic High School.
2. The scholarships will be awarded on the basis of **financial need, entrepreneurial spirit and academic promise**. The Distribution Committee may also wish to consider the student's commitment to volunteer service that benefits the community. This Scholarship is open to students of **all faiths**.
3. These scholarships will be renewable for 3 additional years pending verification from the respective school of the student's continuing to meet the scholarship criteria.
4. Interested candidates/families (students currently in 8th grade at **any school, public or private**) should complete the Scholarship Application Form and submit it with all supporting documentation to their 8<sup>th</sup> grade Principal.
5. The student's 8<sup>th</sup> grade Principal is to complete the Principal Certification section of the Application and attest the application is complete. The application must be forwarded with all supporting documentation to the Archdiocesan High School by the due date established by the High School for review and submission to FACS.
6. **A copy of the student's most recent report card must be included with the application documentation.**
7. The High School Admissions Office is responsible for submitting the completed Scholarship Applications, with all supporting documentation, to the Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools **on or before Friday, March 6, 2026.**

*Renewable awards are conditional upon the Archdiocesan High School providing documentation to FACS each year which verifies that the student remains enrolled, is in good academic standing and has continued financial need.*
