### **Maximilian E. and Marion O. Hoffman Foundation, Inc. Scholarship**

#### **Guidelines and Criteria for the 2026-2027 Award**

The Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools announces the availability of new renewable Maximilian E. and Marion O. Hoffman Foundation, Inc. Scholarships for academic year 2026-2027.

1. The Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools will award **five (5) new 4 yr renewable** scholarships from the Maximilian E. and Marion O. Hoffman Fdn. Scholarship in the amount of **\$1,500 each**, to students **entering (in-coming Freshmen) or currently attending** East Catholic High School, Northwest Catholic High School, and/or St. Paul Catholic High School.
2. The scholarships will be awarded based upon **financial need and academic excellence**.
3. These scholarships will be renewable for 3 additional years pending verification from the respective school of the student's continuing to meet the scholarship criteria.
4. Interested candidates/families of **students currently attending an Archdiocesan High School** should complete the scholarship application and forward it with all supporting documentation to their Principal by the date established by the principal.
5. Interested candidates/families of **incoming freshman applicants should have the student's 8<sup>th</sup> grade** Principal complete the Principal Certification section and attest the application is complete before forwarding the completed application and supporting documentation to the high school by the due date established by the high school who will submit the application to FACS.
6. **A copy of the student's most recent report card must be included with the application.**
7. Completed application forms with all supporting materials are to be forwarded (by the school) to the Foundation of the Advancement of Catholic Schools office **on or before Friday, March 6, 2026**. Supporting materials required to accompany the scholarship application are spelled out on the application form. **FACS will not accept applications that are incomplete, have missing supporting documentation and/or are submitted after the due date.**
