Purpose

The Knights of Columbus Council No. 9 sponsors this scholarship to support Catholic education and to recognize students who demonstrate academic effort, strong character, and a sincere commitment to living the Catholic faith through participation in the life of the Church and service to others.

Scholarship Award

One (1) scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to St. Paul Catholic High School and applied toward tuition for the 2026–2027 academic year.

Eligibility

Applicants must meet each of the following requirements:

- Be a practicing Catholic in good standing who strives to integrate faith into daily life.
- Be a current 8th, 9th, 10th, or 11th grade student (2025–2026) who will attend St. Paul Catholic High School in the 2026–2027 academic year.
- Maintain satisfactory academic standing and school conduct.
- Meet the minimum academic criteria established by the Scholarship Committee (see below).
