

THE MERENDA FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

The Merenda Family Scholarship fund was established by St. Francis de Sales Parish to honor the Merenda Family and was funded with a portion of a bequest received from the estate of Frank Merenda. Scholarships will be awarded annually to St. Francis de Sales parishioners in good standing to:

- 1) Assist with the costs of Catholic education at the elementary or high school level;
- 2) Assist with the costs of post secondary religious studies for priesthood or religious life.

ELIGIBILITY

The scholarship is open to members of St. Francis de Sales parish who are in good standing and who are either enrolled in a Catholic grammar or high school or are enrolled in post secondary religious studies for priesthood or religious life. The scholarship will be given for at least one year, with the possibility of renewal for additional years. Students who have received the award in the past should re-apply each year if they continue to fit the criteria. The number of recipients and the amount awarded shall be based on the amount of funds available.

FACTORS TO BE CONSIDERED

- a) Financial need (40%)
- b) Academic history (20%)
- c) Community service (20%)
- d) Overcome challenges/obstacles (20%)

Minimum of \$1,000.00 in total to be awarded per year. Exact amount of each scholarship and number of scholarships to be awarded each year will be dependent on the number of applicants, the worthiness of the applicants, and the total amount to be awarded for that year.
