Dear families,

In preparation for the upcoming school year, we want to provide you with updated information regarding our school uniform. All changes will also be reflected in the Student Handbook that will be published later this summer.

The Class of 2026 will be grandfathered in with regards to the student uniform. This means that the senior class will be able to wear uniforms purchased from Land's End, Dennis, and/or Tommy Hilfiger. **Grandfathering applies to the company and the school logo, and not the size of the uniform.**

For example, regardless of Class, all male students are expected to wear a shirt that can be tucked in and female students are expected to have a skirt that reaches their mid thigh.

The remaining Classes must purchase their school uniform through our uniform partner, Tommy Hilfiger, with the exception of school pants. Students may purchase pants at a store of their choosing as long as they are khaki color, are not form fitting, and do not have patch pockets. Joggers are also not permitted.

Shoes must be brown or black leather dress shoes. Solid color brown, black, gray, and white boat shoes and sneakers, low top only, are also permitted. Laces and logos must be monochromatic.

Any ongoing medical issues that require medical notes for exemption from school uniform policies must be renewed at the beginning of each school year. A copy of such a note should be forwarded to the school nurse, as well the Dean of Student Life.

We have been collecting uniform donations from past students. If you need a new size and would like to see what I have available in my office, please feel free to contact me. These donated items are free to you. If you would like to try on a new uniform for size from Tommy Hilfiger before you order, I also have most sizes available in my office to sample.
