



# St. Paul Catholic High School Student Uniform

# Introduction



St. Paul Catholic High School's uniform is designed to reinforce neatness, modesty, and provide a cohesive identity of the students of the school. Uniforms can create a focused atmosphere by reducing distractions and thus creating a successful learning environment.

**All uniforms must be purchased through our uniform partner, Tommy Hilfiger, with the exception of school pants.**

Students in the Classes of 2026 and 2027 may wear uniforms previously purchased from other uniform companies, Dennis & Land End, provided they meet the uniform requirements, i.e. can be tucked in and meet length requirements.

# Uniform Pants

Students may purchase pants at a store of their choosing as long as they are khaki color, as shown, are not form fitting, and do not have patch pockets. Joggers are also not permitted.

- From the start of school to Columbus Day and after April vacation khaki or navy chino Bermuda shorts may be worn.
- Solid brown or black leather dress belt required with pants.



# Uniform Skorts for Girls

Besides pants, girls may wear a navy, khaki, or plaid skort or pleated skort from Tommy Hilfiger may also be worn. **Skorts must reach mid-thigh.**

- Tights, knee socks or ankle socks must be worn. Socks must match. Tights must be solid white, navy, or black.



# Uniform Shirts

Uniform shirts must be purchased through Tommy Hilfiger.

- Boys are required to tuck their shirts in.
- Only white tee shirts under a uniform shirt are permitted. Tee shirts can not have slogans or advertisements.

# Uniform Options

The navy performance half zip pullover, full zip polar fleece jacket, and co-ed crewneck sweatshirt from Tommy Hilfiger with the approved logo is an additional uniform cool weather option.

- **The polo shirt must be worn underneath.**
- Students who are members of a team/club may wear their team/club approved apparel **on game day/club day** during their sports/club's season. Clubs must seek permission from the Dean of Student Life to wear applicable attire



# Uniform Shoes

- Shoes must be brown or black leather dress shoes.
- Solid color brown, black, gray, and white boat shoes and sneakers, low top only, are also permitted.
- Laces and logos must be monochromatic. Sandals, slippers, flip flops, work boots, or athletic slides are not permitted.

# Alternate Dress Down Days

- No torn or ripped jeans.
- No t-shirts with references to alcohol, drugs, sex, or race will be allowed.
- No sleeveless tops, tank tops, midriff tops or low-cut tops.
- No sandals, flip-flops, or athletic slides.
- No shorts or skirts that are shorter than mid-thigh.
- No leggings or yoga pants
- No pajamas, except for designated spirit days.
- No wallet chains.

# Additional Uniform Requirements

See handbook for all additional uniform requirements. These include, but are not limited to:

- Boys must be clean shaven.
- No earrings for boys.
- No student may have a facial piercing. New piercings may not be covered if obtained during the school year.
- Tattoos are not allowed and should be covered at all times.
- Hair color must be a natural color.
