- Provide access to scholarships and enrichment activities
- Coordinate PSAT, SAT, ACT and Advanced Placement Exams
- Coordinate school transcripts, letters of recommendations, and the school profile to send to colleges

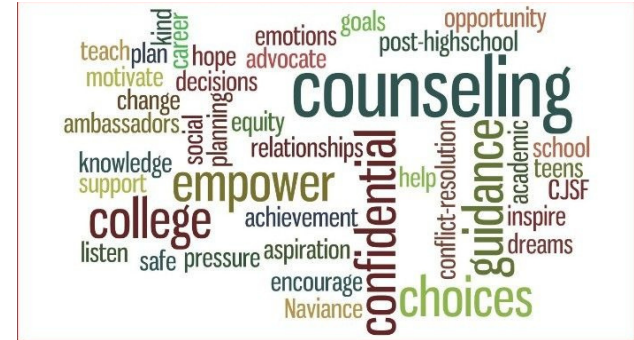
WHAT SCHOOL COUNSELORS DO:

WHAT SCHOOL COUNSELORS DO: PERSONAL, SOCIAL, AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Meet with Freshmen on a monthly basis to check in and help with the transition to high school
- Develop stress reduction and coping skills
- Individual counseling as needed for each student
- Assist students and families in transitions

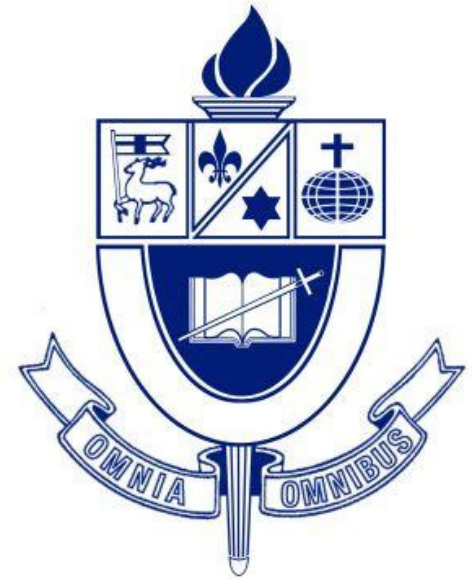
