Incoming applicants must have applied to and been accepted by St. Paul Catholic High School. Final determination of the award recipient will be made by the Krawiecki Family Scholarship Committee, in consultation with St. Paul Catholic High School.

Deadline: Interested candidates should complete this application and send it to the St. Paul Catholic High School Finance Office by **February 1, 2022**. *In addition,* a tuition assistance application should be submitted to FACTS Grant & Aid by **January 17, 2022**.
