Bishop Peter A. Rosazza Scholarship

Guidelines and Criteria for 2022-2023 Award

The Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools (FACS) invites applications for a Bishop Peter A. Rosazza Scholarship for the 2022-2023 Academic Year.

1. The Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools will award **one renewable scholarship in the amount of \$1,575 to an incoming Freshman entering** one of the Archdiocesan High Schools: East Catholic High School, Northwest Catholic High School and St. Paul Catholic High School.
2. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of **financial need and academic excellence to students who are of Hispanic descent.**
3. High School Admissions Offices will distribute applications to **ALL** accepted students who have **demonstrated financial need** and meet the criteria and requirements of the scholarship award.
4. Interested candidates/families (**students currently in the 8th grade attending Hartford Archdiocesan Catholic Schools**) should complete the Scholarship Application Form and forward it, with all supporting documentation, to the 8th grade Principal.
5. The student's 8th grade Principal is to complete the Principal Certification section (Application Page 4) and attest the application is complete. The application must be forwarded with all supporting documentation to the Archdiocesan High School by the due date established by the High School, **Monday, March 28, 2022.**
6. **A copy of the student's most recent report card must be included with the application documentation.**
7. The High School Admissions Office is responsible for submitting the completed Scholarship Applications, with supporting documentation, to the Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools on or before Thursday, March 31, 2022.

APPLICATIONS SUBMITTED AFTER THE DUE DATE WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

Renewable awards are conditional upon the Archdiocesan High School providing documentation to FACS each year which verifies that the student remains enrolled, is in good academic standing and has continued financial need. Value of renewal award may vary slightly due to availability of funds.
