## Guidelines and Criteria for the 2023-2024 Award

The Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools announces the availability of new renewable Maximilian E. and Marion O. Hoffman Foundation, Inc. Scholarships for academic year 2023-2024.

- 1. The Foundation for the Advancement of Catholic Schools will award ten (10) renewable scholarships in the amount of \$1,500.00, to students entering (incoming Freshmen) or currently attending East Catholic High School, Northwest Catholic High School, and/or St. Paul Catholic High School.
- 2. The scholarships will be awarded based upon **financial need and academic excellence.**
- 3. These scholarships will be renewable for up to 3 additional years pending verification from the respective school of the student's continuing to meet the scholarship criteria.
- 4. Interested candidates/families of **students currently attending St. Paul Catholic High School** should complete the Scholarship Application Form and forward it, with all supporting documentation to the school Finance Office by **Tuesday, March 21, 2023**.
- 5. Interested candidates/families of **incoming freshmen applicants** should have the **student's 8**<sup>th</sup> **grade Principal** complete the Principal Certification section (Application Page 5) and attest the application is complete before forwarding the completed application and supporting documentation to the high school by the due date established by the high school principal, **Tuesday, March 21, 2023.**
- 6. A copy of the student's most recent report card must be included with the application.
- 7. Completed application forms with all supporting materials are to be forwarded (by the school) to the Foundation of the Advancement of Catholic Schools office on or before Monday, March 27, 2023. Supporting materials required to accompany the scholarship application are spelled out on the application form. FACS will not accept applications that are incomplete, have missing supporting documentation and/or are submitted after the due date.
